Ans- deer, field- common noun. Pack of wolves- col. noun

4. Our Principal has both wisdom and knowledge, but a short temper.

Ans- Principal- Common noun. Wisdom and knowledge- abstract noun.

5. Doctors use thermometer to measure temperature.

Ans- Doctors, thermometer- common noun. Temperature- abstract noun.

6. Shah Jahan built the Taj Mahal at Agra in the memory of his wife.

Ans- Shah Jahan, Taj Mahal, Agra- proper noun. memory- abstract noun. Wife- common noun

7. Aleena visited her friend in the hospital and took a bouquet of flowers for her.

Ans- Aleena- proper noun. friend, hospital- common noun. bouquet

of flowers- col. Noun.

Ans- Greatness, kindness, happiness, laziness, darkness,
